This document updates the rules governing Glenbrook Rotary markets in the wake of the COVID19 epidemic.

Glenbrook Rotary markets are conducted by the Lower Blue Mountains Rotary club as a community service and to help fund various Rotary projects locally and internationally. Funds are also raised for Springwood High School, which currently administers our Markets site. We run on the first and third Saturday of each month, except January

All members involved in the running of these markets are volunteers so please be patient if there is a delay in communication. We aim to have a relaxed and friendly yet efficiently organised market.

Glenbrook Rotary markets are predominantly a craft and produce market with a range of quality products for sale. A variety of stallholders are desired to help ensure a good range of product is available for sale. No stall holder will have a monopoly on any one type of goods. If your item would be acceptable to sell at the market but currently other stalls offer similar goods, you may be placed on a waiting list until a vacancy arises. Decisions are made in the best interest of the market and we reserve the right to withdraw approval for stalls at our discretion.

Our Rotary Club's Book Fair also operates at each Market while the Rotary Barbecue will resume in 2021 on the third Saturday Market of each month.
